

# CANDIDATE DIALOGUE GUIDE

## Beginning

### 1. Are you from (current city) originally?

Note: Once the candidate answers, initiate small talk about the city, traffic, weather, etc. Offer personal info as well. *Ex.* I grew up in...

- **2. Are you still with (***current employer***)?** Skip if currently unemployed. Ask about their prior job instead. *Ex*. How long were you with (*company*)?
- 3. What's the work culture like there? I've always been curious.
- **4. Well, I'm certainly glad we're on your radar. But I do have to ask, what has you thinking about making a transition?** Dig deeper into this question. *Ex.* If their answer is because of a boss or coworkers, ask for details. *Ex.* If the answer is money, ask if they requested a raise and/or what made them feel undervalued.

### Middle

- 5. What does the *perfect* work environment look like to you?
- 6. What are the top two or three things that you're looking for in your next role and company?
- 7. Career-wise, what are you most proud of?
- 8. What did you like most about working for (current/prior employer)?
- 9. Given the task, how would you have made them a more efficient company?
- 10. Who was the best boss you've ever had and why? What about the worst?

#### Close

- **11-13. Job-specific questions.** Choose questions that are specific to the role or industry. Ones that require insider knowledge to answer. *Ex.* What temperature do you typically cook your rare steaks to before taking them off the grill?
- **14. What challenges do you see in our industry ten years from now?** Offer insight or thoughts of your own.
